

# Full-Stack Web Developer

The Web Developer is responsible for the prioritization of Web projects assigned by the Project Manager and Creative Directors and for the building of those Web projects. This person continually learns of new development software and is responsible for the integrity of internally created or supported websites. The Web Developer also works with the Creative Directors and Project Manager to develop the Web services workflows for the studio; including gathering features requirements, database management, software development, testing, implementation, user follow-up, support and technical project management.

## Responsibilities:

1. Responsible for all aspects of development and support for internally created or supported websites. **PER PROJECT**
2. Choose the development methodologies and technologies (language, databases, collaboration, and support tools) for the studio. **WEEKLY AS NEEDED**
3. Setup and test software and hosting environments for internally created websites. **WEEKLY AS NEEDED**
4. Manage the website development sub-contractor staff and web project workload for the studio. **PER PROJECT**
5. Work directly with the team to brainstorm, conceptualize and imagine website content and feature solutions. **PER PROJECT**
6. Review creative briefs and take lead from Creative Director and Project Manager. **PER PROJECT**
7. Communicate directly with clients and manage website pipeline. **DAILY**
8. Maintain a billable hours time sheet, personal task / meetings calendar, and to-do list. **WEEKLY AS NEEDED**
9. Liaison with I.T. vendor(s) as necessary to troubleshoot issues, complete projects, and equip studio technology infrastructure. **WEEKLY AS NEEDED**
10. Assist the Creative Directors and Project Manager with client job tasks including web design, data entry, content management, and social media posts. **PER PROJECT**

2. Proficient in languages PHP, HTML, CSS, and front-end JavaScript.
3. Strong understanding of Graphic Design and UI/UX trends and best practices.
4. Must be comfortable developing custom Wordpress themes.
5. Must be able to use Git on a regular basis.
6. Must be comfortable integrating with third-party software using APIs.
7. Some experience using relational databases (MySQL).
8. Experience with frameworks such as Rails, Angular, Node, etc. are a plus.
9. Experience with tools such as Bower, Grunt, SASS, etc. are a plus.
10. Ability to work and learn at the same time.
11. Ability to manage and switch between assignments on a regular basis.
